



Lots has been going on behind the scenes since our sale and I want to bring you all up to date on what has been happening.

First off our sale was a tremendous success - far better than we thought it would be. And this is due to all our volunteers and the wonderful community that we live in which supported us all the way - from making copious donations to coming out in droves on the sale days. Our Book Bonanza Board has been able to support our two nonprofit organizations (Berks County Public Libraries and the Reading Branch of the AAUW) to the tune of \$20,000

each!!! And this is from a sale that from start to finish was less than 4 months. You all deserve a pat on the back.

Now, once we get through the holidays, we can begin to turn our attention towards our 2025 sale. This sale will return to our regular time frame and will take place in July. This will give us almost 6 months to collect, sort, and display our items. We've had a dry run in our new home space. We will make a few changes in how we set up for the sale, but things shouldn't be so frantic.

Here is the important information for you to have:

We will begin accepting donations on Monday, January 6, 2025, at our Mohnton location. At least for January and February we will be accepting donations only on Mondays and Tuesdays from 9:00-12:00. There will be no Wednesday donations during this time because it is both cold and dark - and we don't want our volunteers to be subjected to this. We will revise the days/times once Daylight Savings Time resumes.

Also please note that we will NOT accept donations on Monday holidays.

Also we will NOT be accepting donations on days that Gov. Mifflin School District is closed for weather related issues (you can check this out on the Mifflin website - <u>gmsd.org</u>

We have no idea what the volume of the donations will be in the beginning, so you do not have to feel you need to come out at once. Even if there are no donations at first, we still have lots of straightening up to do with the books that remained after our last sale. We will have guidelines for new sorters to help you get started, and there will always be board members, genre leaders, and prior sorters to give you support. So come when you are able to, as much or as little as you want, and we will always find something for you to do.
